## mARRAdhE pAl soriyum

Let us enjoy the multiple meanings of "*mARRAdhE*", in the phrase "*mARRAdhE pAl soriyum*", brought out by Sri U Ve P B Annangarachariar Swami.

*pAl* - Milk, refers to the divine auspicious qualities of the Lord (*'unadhu pAlE pOl sIril pazhuththozhindhEn'* - Periya Thiruvandhadhi). This milk is poured out by the acharyas to their disciples. In this phrase, what does *'mARRAdhE'* mean?

- Manavala Mamnuigal explains the correct way to state things 'munnOr mozhindha muRai thappAmal kEttup pinnOrndhu thAmadhanai'. There are many who change this. One should not do that. That is, not changing the ways of the Purvacharyas.
- Saying one thing one day; finding an error in it themselves the next day, retracting it; saying a different thing on the third day; etc. There are some people who do that. Not being like that; saying the true meaning the first time and being steady.
- Not stating things such that another person finds an error in what one says; and then having to declare a different meaning. That is, not having to change.
- Being able to teach all the meanings so one's disciple does not have to go to another acharya for other meanings. That is, not having to change the acharya.
- ➤ mARRAdhE EmARRAdhE : Not having the desire to cheat by teaching falsities.
- Continuous that is, teaching without a break.
